4 On 10/20/2021 Deputy Naylor was dispatched to in reference to a 9-1-1 hang up call. While enroute to the											
5 address, dispatch advised Deputy Naylor, a female could be heard crying in the background, however the phone was not answered when dispatch											
6 called back. Upon arrival Deputy Naylor met with (V1) who advised the following:

8 advised she and her husband Kyle Welch (D1) had an argument earlier this morning. Five children were in the living room when this argument											
9 began: (W1), (W2), (O1), (O2), and (O3). and Kyle went into their											
10 bedroom and continued the verbal argument. noted while arguing with her husband she took off her wedding rings, and threw them across the											
11 room. Kyle picked up the rings and went to the hallway to put the rings in the safe, did not have access to. advised she reached for her											
12 wedding rings, and Kyle pushed her up against the wall. told deputies she was yelling through the duration of the altercation between the two.											
13 noted after being pushed Kyle spit in her face. After this occurred advised she yelled she was going to call 9-1-1, which made the two											
14 physically separate into different areas of the home. advised several times she was nervous due to Kyle being the only person working, and											
15 she should not have called 9-1-1, it was a family matter. had no visible injuries to her person. completed a sworn written VSO

16 statement (Domestic Violence Pamphlet), and refused medical attention. [redacted] noted she did not wish to press charges. A VSO case card, and a
17 Legal Rights and Remedies Pamphlet was given to [redacted] which she signed for receiving. She has elected to prevent disclosure of confidential or
18 privileged information per Marsy's Law.
19
20 Deputy Naylor next spoke to Kyle who advised he and his wife [redacted] had been involved in a verbal dispute. Kyle advised he has some anger
21 problems and wanted help with his anger issues. Kyle noted he and his wife had been arguing very loudly in front of the children, and that should not
22 have happened. When asked if [redacted] had gotten physical with Kyle during the dispute, he advised she had not. Kyle advised at no time did the
23 dispute ever get physical.
24
25 Deputy Naylor next spoke to [redacted] [redacted] advised she was sleeping, and woke up to her mother and Kyle arguing. After waking up
26 [redacted] yelled for all of the kids to get in the car. Kyle next yelled for the kids to get out. When her mother came outside the kids went back into the
27 home. While the children were inside they began speaking to each other advising Kyle had choked [redacted] [redacted] noted that [redacted] had
28 observed and was a witness to the argument. [redacted] advised she had not witnessed anything but was convinced Kyle had choked, punched, and spit
29 on [redacted]
30
31 When Deputy Naylor made contact with [redacted] he was visibly upset. He began crying, and stated he did not want his father to go to jail. When asked
32 why his father would go to jail, [redacted] noted Kyle had pinned [redacted] against the wall, spit in her face, and that he punched her. [redacted] advised [redacted]
33 and Kyle were arguing and yelling. While the two were yelling in their bedroom he attempted to calm his siblings down. Due to how loud the two were
34 arguing, [redacted] overheard Kyle yelling about [redacted] throwing her rings. [redacted] stated as the two came out of the bedroom they were "calm for a
35 second", and walked into the hallway. [redacted] then overheard [redacted] yell don't pin me up against the wall. He next heard his dad spit in [redacted] face.
36 [redacted] noted he heard his father make the sound of spitting, and was able to provide an example of what the sound commonly associated with
37 forcibly ejecting the saliva from the mouth. [redacted] overheard [redacted] yell to Kyle to hit her again. Next [redacted] noted Kyle went into the bathroom but
38 he was unsure of what he was doing in the bathroom. Kyle yelled at [redacted] stating "do you want to see this red mark", however [redacted] could not
39 elaborate on this statement or what Kyle could have meant. [redacted] next told the kids to get in the car. [redacted] noted he has also seen his biological
40 mother get into physical altercations with her boyfriends in the past.
41
42 While on scene, Deputy Naylor observed [redacted] to be very concerned about the possibility of Kyle losing his job. She advised frequently, their
43 household was single income and she was aware about how Domestic Violence worked in this state. She advised multiple times Kyle was a good
44 man and she did not wish for him to go to jail, and simply wished for him to receive mental health treatment for his anger. [redacted] frequently changed
45 her story, downplaying their disturbance to make it seem as though Kyle had not spit on her. This all seemed to be in an attempt to keep Kyle from
46 going to jail. When Deputy Naylor first spoke with Kyle she observed him to be in a very somber mood. He did not speak much, but could be seen
47 hugging and kissing all of his children goodbye. The children in the household seemed to be in a good mood, apart from [redacted] being aware of the
48 possibility of his father going to jail.
49
50 Based on the information and statements obtained from all parties involved, Deputy Naylor determined Kyle was the primary aggressor, and he was
51 subsequently arrested for Battery (Domestic Violence). Kyle and [redacted] are legally married, and were married on September 17th, 2021, and have
52 been in a domestic relationship for five (5) years. Kyle and [redacted] also have one child in common [redacted]
53
54 Before transporting Kyle to the Debary District office, he exclaimed [redacted] hit him on his upper right hand side shoulder, and that he had a welt on his
55 back from the blow. Deputy Naylor checked the whole of Kyle's back, and was unable to feel or observe any welt or red marks. While driving to the
56 Debary District office Kyle spontaneously uttered he knows he has PTSD and advised due to financial issues he has been stressed in an attempt to
57 care for seven (7) individuals.
58
59 Due to the children being in the home and observing part of the disturbance between [redacted] and Kyle, DCF was notified.
60
61 Sgt. Hillyard was aware of this call for service, due to being Deputy Naylor's backup. The weekend Watch Commander Lt. Rahn was notified, who
62 subsequently made the proper notifications up the chain of command, and notified Captain Anderson of the Deland Police Department.
63
64 Kyle was later transported to the Volusia County Branch Jail without incident.
